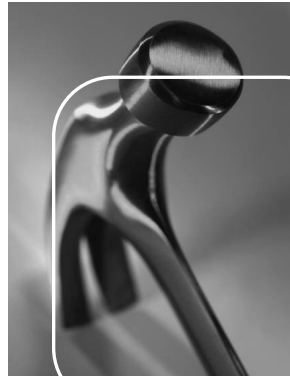
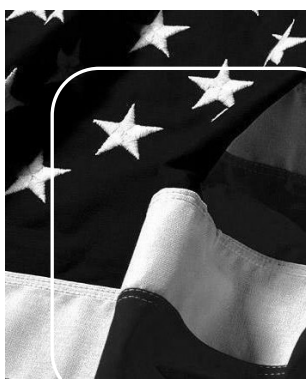


FUN & EDUCATIONAL SUMMER CAMPS @ THE HEISEY

Equipment & Lunches: Each camper will need to wear non-marking soled tennis shoes, no flip-flops and bring a jacket just in case of bad weather. Each camper **MUST** bring a sack lunch each day of camp. Two snacks will be provided each day of camp, morning and afternoon. Campers must also have their own water bottles each day of camp.
